7. For the purpose of carrying out object of the Society and for providing the facilities and undertaking the activities as mentioned above. The members shall be entitled to utilize the funds of the members as well as its income in such a manner as they shall be in their prudence and judicious discretion deem it proper.

8. To do business only it is incidental to the attainment of the objectives of the Society and with in the parameters lay down in section 11 (4A) of the Income Tax Act 1961.

9. Being a Society it will be IRREVOCABLE for all time.

10. Whereas the Society shall be in the even of the dissolution or winding of the Society the funds shall not be paid or distributed among its members but shall be given to such other Society which having similar aims and objects of this Society as may be determined by the General Body Members.

11. The amendments if any made to the Society Byelaw will not be extended to alter the basis character / object of the Society and no such amendment which may prove to be repugnant to the provision of section 2 (15) 11, 12A, 12AA, and 80G of the Income Tax Act 1961.

The Society shall be entitled to borrow loans from any State Government or Central Government, Nationalized or scheduled Banks or any financial institutions or Non-Government financial institutions any abroad agencies loan scheme or lending to Self Help Group / institutions and etc. and disburse of the same to needy people and to collect the loans and repay it.

#### 18. DONATIONS:

The Society may accept any donation, contribution, grant or subscription in cash or in kind any person, institution or Body of Individuals or Association of Persons or Society of organizations, with or without conditions from India and Abroad. In case of receipt of foreign donations, permission from the Ministry of Home Affairs, India will have to be obtained and code number will be obtained.

#### 19. DISSOLUTION:

When ever necessity arises for dissolution of the society the concerned Sections of the Tamil Nadu Societies Registration Act 1975 will be followed. No property shall be divided among the members. But the property of the society shall be entrusted with other societies, which has similar objects and activities recognized by the Commissioner of Income Tax.
